Medical assessment and provision of retro-viral drugs is not available in the North East area of D R Congo. IPASC has established a relationship with a hospital in Arua across the border in Uganda. IPASC has a



voluntary screening programme in Aru. The purpose built building has offices, counselling rooms, a general meeting/waiting room, laboratory and at the front offices for the Safe Motherhood Department.
